Rob Tucker lives and works in Auckland, NZ. Tucker has become known for his distinct renderings of figurative still-lifes and landscapes executed through geometric shapes, simplified forms and a playful palette.

Referencing mid-century modern design, Tucker's nostalgic work is reminiscent of David Hockney's era of pop-art and abstraction. Oversized, textural and graphic, Tucker's work is an exploration colour and composition.

Tucker has exhibited in London, New York, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Miami, Berlin, Hong Kong, Singapore & Tel Aviv.

The new body of work is comprised of a selection of still life and floral arrangements, playing with spontaneity, colour, and mark-making. Tucker has drawn inspiration from Morandi to construct whimsical still-life clusters and compositions.
